### **Day Nursery**

Last week Fox class excitedly continued their learning around 'people who help us' focusing on medical professions including doctors, nurses, dentists and vets.

The children explored these different roles throughout the week through a range of activities and role play experiences. These included exploring the importance of oral hygiene and brushing your teeth, painting with tooth brushes, developing an understanding of one-to-one correspondences whilst counting teeth in a mouth, looking after the sick animals at our role-play vets and caring for the babies on our Woodentops hospital ward. During this role-play experience the children especially enjoyed applying bandages and plasters to the injured babies and learning about the appropriate language within each occupation for example stethoscope, antiseptic, hygiene. Meanwhile Bunny have been making crowns for the Queen's birthday and taking part in a role-play tea party and mark making to create their own bus tickets to travel on their pretend bus and also made Father's Day cards.

This week the children are continuing their learning around 'people who help us' and will be focusing on occupations that work out on our streets, they will also be enjoying menu C for lunch and tea.
