Congratulations to Rafi Davis and Amelie Zwi who have been selected to represent the school as Head Boy and Head Girl this year.




Well Done...

September Clubs

Please see attached the clubs list for September 2016. This is also on the noticeboard next to the entrance. Clubs start on Monday 12th September. Karate will begin Wednesday 14th September at the normal time.

Please add your child's name to the sheet or let the office know if your child would like to join a club. Most clubs will have a set number of places, so please ensure you sign up swiftly. Paid clubs this term are:

- Funky Moves will continue on a Monday 4pm - 5pm for Rec - Year 6.
- Gym Club will continue on Tuesdays 4pm - 5pm for Rec - Year 6
- Drama Club will continues on Fridays 3pm - 4.45pm for Rec -Year 6

I have also been approached about the possibility of a **sewing club**. This can take place on a Thursday or Tuesday evening and will run 4pm - 5pm and can take up to 10 children from year 4 upwards to teach them the life skill of sewing. The children make a number of projects each term (see below) and learn the basics of starting and securing their stitches, basic running stitch and simple embroidery stitches. The club is charged at £10 per child per week and this includes all materials and also a folder with worksheets detailing each skill.

If I have 10 children showing interest in this club I will happily book it to start in September If your child is attending a club please feel free to pack a snack for them to eat at the end of the school day before their club.

Reception club will take place between Monday - Thursday (3-4pm). A variety of activities are available for the children including: arts and crafts, sporting activities, playing and cooking. For those parents wishing for their child to attend, please supply a snack.

Gabriel our Karate teacher will be offering a free taster session to all children who are considering taking up Karate. This will take place at St Stephens Church Hall on Weir Road Wednesday 21st September 7.35am.
