Woodentops Kindergarten is part of the Lambeth Early Years Development Partnership. This Nursery Education Funding (NEF) provides a free entitlement of 15 hours for all 3 and 4 year olds, of approximately £1000 (pro rata) per term, for a maximum of six terms. Enrichment activities are included in the fees of all nursery pupils but are not funded by the NEF grant. These activities include Ballet, French, Football & Sports coaching, Midmorning snack, Music & movement, Singing & Recorder, Swimming and Yoga.

Registration fee (non-returnable) £70.00

- For children entering the Pre Reception a deposit of £1000.00 is payable on acceptance of a place. This amount is refundable 3 weeks after the child leaves the school but is not re-fundable should the child not take up the place.
- $\bullet$  For children entering the Preparatory School into Reception class, a deposit of £3000 must be paid by the end of the Autumn half term prior to September entry. This deposit is refundable 3 weeks after the child leaves the school but is not re-fundable should the child not take up the place.
- Fees may be paid by standing order over a 10 month period for families with 2 or more children attending the school.





- A credit of 5% is given when a sibling attends the Kindergarten or Preparatory School concurrently.
- Fees for the White House School are inclusive of all tuition, games, swimming, art instruction and materials and all after school clubs excluding Karate, Drama Club, Gymnastics Club, Dragons (Mandarin) Club, Early Bird Club and Homework Club. Fees do not include lunch, the Outdoor Adventure Education visit, trips or individual instrumental lessons.
- Catered school lunch is provided for all pupils from Reception to Year 6. This is invoiced separately from the fees.
- Fees are payable on the first day of each term. Fees are reviewed annually. A full term's notice of intention to withdraw a pupil from the school must be given in writing to the Principal. Unless such notice is given the payment of a term's fees will be required in lieu of notice.
