The White House Prep and Woodentops Nursery is part of the Lambeth Early Years Development Partnership.

This Nursery Education Funding (NEF) provides a funded entitlement of 15 hours for all 3 and 4 year olds, of approximately £1000 (pro rata) per term, for a maximum of six terms. Enrichment activities are included in the fees of all nursery pupils but are not funded by the NEF grant. These activities include Ballet, French, Sports lessons, mid-morning snack, Drama, Singing, Swimming and Yoga.

Registration fee (non-returnable) £70.00

- For children entering the Preparatory School, a deposit of £3000 must be paid prior to their entry. This deposit is refundable 3 weeks after the child leaves the school but is not re-refundable should the child not take up the place.
- Fees may be paid by standing order over a 10 month period for families with 2 or more children attending the school.

- A sibling discount of 5% is given when a sibling attends the School concurrently.
- Fees for the White House School are inclusive of all tuition, games, swimming, art instruction and materials and all after school clubs excluding Karate, Drama Club, Gymnastics Club, Early Bird Club and Homework Club. Fees do not include lunch, the Outdoor Adventure Education visit, trips or individual instrumental lessons.
- Catered school lunch is provided for all pupils from Reception to Year 6. This is invoiced separately from the fees.
- Fees are payable on the first day of each term. Fees are reviewed annually. A full term's notice of intention to withdraw a pupil from the school must be given in writing to the Principal. Unless such notice is given the payment of a term's fees will be required in lieu of notice.
- A full term's notice in writing is required or a full term's fees are payable in lieu. Fees are due by the first day of each term. Interest of £10.00 per week will be added to fees not paid by the end of the first week of a new term, unless other arrangements have been previously agreed with Mrs McCahery.
- The White House accepts childcare vouchers to cover costs of Early Birds, Homework Club. They can also be used to pay school fees if your child is under statutory school age at the start of the relevant term. Our usual terms and conditions apply.
